With your help USB purchased warm clothes, blankets, medication, generators, fuel and gas, items for baby care, multi-functional solar torches with light, alarm and charger and so much more.





The Dvorichna community in the Kharkiv region has been heavily exposed to the war. From 4,000 people formerly living in the community, some 300 stayed - a mix of older people, women and even some families with children.



The community is led by Mayor Galina. She is doing her best to support her people, but without access to food, water and heating it is a very difficult task. Many houses are ruined. People live in groups from 5 to 20 together with pets in the basements of multi-store apartments.



Our partner volunteers from the Khaustov Fund (Kharkiv) made an inventory of things that are needed for each basement group to survive for the next two months. Along with food parcels provided by volunteers, USB purchased warm clothes, blankets, candles and multi-functional solar torches (light, alarm, charger), medication, heating and cooking devices, generators, fuel and gas, items for baby care, sanitation items and pet food.



Some families staying in their private houses with solid basements received equipment and supplies for insulation, heating and cooking.

Additionally, our partner volunteers were equipped with missing safety uniform.
